DEFINITIONS OF ALCOHOL DEPENDENCE AND ABUSE:

DEPENDENCE ...is diagnosed when you have withdrawals and are unsuccessful in controlling consumption.

ABUSE ... is diagnosed by alcohol interfering in major obligations to family, work, or school and using alcohol in hazardous situations.


